DREMC offers programs for all ages of students that range from electric safety to saving energy to touring our nation's capital! Here are brief descriptions of the presentations and youth programs we offer.

(Scheduling preference will be given to those schools in the DREMC service area.)

Play It Safe Around Electricity

Our *Louie the Lightning Bug* DVD video teaches students in grades K through 3 what electricity is and how we can stay safe around electricity in and outside the home. This program also includes a coloring contest with prizes awarded for first place in each classroom and Louie stickers for all students.

Electric Safety Tabletop Demonstration

DREMC's tabletop demonstration shows students, through energized scenarios, how certain objects and people can conduct electricity. The tabletop demo is perfect for grades K through 8.

High-Voltage Safety Trailer Demonstration

This outdoor electric safety demonstration simulates real-life situations to show students how electricity works, what happens when the power goes out and stages various dangerous scenarios that can lead to serious injury. Students will witness electrical arcs - and even fire - as electricity is conducted by various objects when in contact with overhead and underground power lines. Through each scenario, employees teach valuable safety lessons. The safety trailer demo is best suited for students in grades 7 through 12.
