It also allows members to reduce deposits and fees required when applying for service.

Instead of a monthly billing statement, your electric use and balance are calculated daily. Simply track your electric use through DREMC's website or use our mobile app. Ask us for details!

Monitor and control your prepaid electric use with our mobile app!

How does it work?

With DREMC's PowerUP Prepay, you purchase electric service before you use it. You have more flexibility of making payments as you monitor and manage your account. You can pay online, use our mobile app, pay by phone 24/7 or pay in person during regular business hours at your local DREMC office. When your account runs low, you will get an alert by text or email letting you know that it's time to recharge your account with another prepayment.

What are the benefits?

There are many benefits to being a PowerUP Prepay member of DREMC, and they are listed here. Perhaps one of the most immediate benefits for a new DREMC member is eliminating the credit check and reducing the amount of your deposit at the time you apply for electric service. Check with us to see if this is the best option for you.

What if my prepaid amount runs out?

If funds in your account run out, electric service will be disconnected. You will be notified that service will be disconnected if you don't recharge your account. You can purchase more power by using one of the payment methods listed above. If your account is disconnected before you can make a payment, all unpaid balances and fees must be paid.

Who can participate?

PowerUP Prepay is available to new and existing residential DREMC members. Please note that at this time, DREMC is in the process of installing advanced meter technology that will provide for improved communication for the prepay program in some areas.

By monitoring energy use with DREMC's mobile app and adjusting habits and appliance operation, you can actually reduce the amount of electricity you use each day and save money.

The DREMC mobile app can be used by all our members. Those who use our mobile app to access their PowerUP Prepay accounts have the ability at their fingertips to:

- Make payments
- Monitor daily electric use
- Check account balances
- View historical billing and kWh use
- Receive text alerts and reminders
- Set your own alerts
- Report an outage
- View DREMC's outage map

The prepay feature on our mobile app, shown at right, allows you to view detailed account history that shows daily kWh use. To figure the estimated cost of the energy you've used, simply multiply the daily kWh by DREMC's current rate of approximately 10 cents. You can now calculate a rough estimate of your daily energy cost!
