501-15,000 kWh	<b>\$50.11</b>

	Base	Fuel	Total Cents/kWh
Energy Charge: 0 - 1,000 kWh	0.09723	0.03756	<b>0.13479</b>
Energy Charge: 1,001 - 3,000 kWh	0.09735	0.03756	<b>0.13491</b>
Energy Charge > 3,000 kWh	0.09048	0.03756	<b>0.12804</b>

### Example shown for non-residential bill calculation for 1,500 kWh used

Customer Charge:	\$50.11
Base energy charge X number of kWh used (0 - 1,000 kWh):	\$97.23
Base energy charge X number of kWh used (1,001 - 3,000 kWh):	\$48.68
Base energy charge (> 3,000 kWh) X number of kWh used (0 kWh):	\$0.00
Total Fuel Cost X number of kWh used (1,500 kWh):	<u>\$56.34</u>
<b>Total Non-Residential Bill Amount</b>	<b>\$252.36*</b>

Energy Rates for power users with a demand greater than 60 kW are much more complex and have many more variables than those published here. \*\*Total Fuel - TVA calculates and applies the Total Fuel Cost Adjustment monthly and adds or subtracts a per kilowatt-hour charge to recover generating fuel costs when those costs exceed or are below the amount budgeted. The Total Fuel Cost can fluctuate up or down depending on how actual fuel costs compare to TVA's projected expenditures.

**69%** of rates pays for wholesale power purchased from TVA



**31%** of rates pays for DREMC operations
